Titchy Town is based on the site of Scallywags Private Day Nursey in Chellaston (Rowallan Way, DE73 5WX). Hero Town is based on the site of Scallywaqs Private Day Nursery in Melbourne (Castle Lane, DE73 8JB). Please use Scallywags car park at both sites. You will find signage in both car parks on how to access the centres.

How it works?

Both role play centres work on a pre-book via our website and pay on arrival basis with sessions lasting 90 minutes. On your first entry you will be issued a loyalty card and for every nine sessions you attend you will receive your 10th entry free of charge! Loyalty cards can be used across both sites. Payment is cash only.



Childcare funding for working parents

From September 2025:

If your child turns 9 months old on or before the 31 August 2025, then if you are eligible, you will receive 1140 funded hours per year starting in September 2025. In Derby, this is called Take Off early learning childcare. You must reconfirm your eligibility for Take Off funded early learning childcare and Tax Free Childcare every 3 months with HRMC through your Government Gateway account. If you apply more than 3 months before the term starts, you'll have to reconfirm your eligibility in your account to keep your code valid.

Derby Forest School runs sessions in South Derbyshire for children of all ages.

The Nature Nursery run by Derby Forest School runs in the beautiful woodland at Whistlewood Common near Melbourne and offers an outstanding opportunity for children to run wild and free in a stunning location whilst receiving high quality education from exceptional early years staff. Catering for children from 2.5 upwards the nursery provides full day Forest School on Monday - Wednesday throughout the year and accepts all the usual childcare funding options including offering the government funded 15/30 hours.



Children participate in a range of fantastic experiences including cooking on a campfire, den building and relaxing in the hammocks as well as learning about nature, wildlife, weather and the wider environment.



As well as the beautiful woodland, children have access to a warm and cosy straw bale roundhouse in the winter months, a yurt, fruit orchards, wildlife ponds and a community garden where they help with growing vegetables and fruit which are used in their daily snacks.

The ethos of the setting allows children the freedom to explore and discover all that nature has to offer with the support of enthusiastic adults who will delight in childrens' sense of awe and wonder. The curriculum follows children's interests and builds on what they already know skillfully, to prepare them for the next step in their learning. Whether they spend their days cooking up a storm in the mud kitchen, climbing trees, building tunnels in the digging area or creating crafts with natural resources children have fun, make friends and end each day, tired and happy.

Connected Perinatal Support



A day in the life of a Peer Supporter

At Connected we provide free peer support to parents across Derby from pregnancy through to 2 years after birth, but have you ever wondered what that actually looks like? Here's Steph's insight into what working as a Community Peer Support Worker at Connected involves.

My journey with Connected started as a trainee and I was lucky enough to get a paid role just before the end of my training. The training with Connected gave me the best start in my peer support journey, providing me with a tool belt of knowledge and confidence to provide support to families safely with my lived experience.



My job is so varied – no day or week is ever the same! I love getting to meet so many amazing families along the way. Some of my work is on the antenatal and postnatal wards and the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at Derby Hospital, meeting families and giving them a safe space to talk and offload. I also provide birth support on the labour ward – it's amazing being part of someone's journey and empowering them to make the right decision for themselves and their babies.

Running our free, drop-in parent and baby groups in the community is a big part of my role. We have groups all over Derby to give mums, dads and non-birthing parents a safe, relaxed space to meet other parents, have a drink, a biscuit and chat with other parents and peer supporters.

I also provide 1-1 support for families. This can be face-to-face at the person's home, on the phone or at a place picked by the parent. Support is individual to that parent and starts in pregnancy and continues up until 12 weeks postnatally. One of my favorite things about the job is the amazing volunteers I get to see on a weekly basis. I get to introduce new volunteers to different parts of the community and watch them shine at what they do best.

We train volunteers every year. I would encourage anyone interested in volunteering for Connected to go for it, you won't look back! I learnt so much on my training and developed some amazing friendships within my cohort.






