Have eco-council complete 'hands-up' activity in their classes to see which children are reading the section on the newsletter.

<u>Eco-Schools Topic</u> School Grounds/ Waste	<u>Action</u> - Have a compost bin for the school. - Have Waste monitors that collect fruit and vegetable waste and take it to the compost bin. - Start a gardening club to teach children how to grow and look after plants	<u>Duration</u> Spring- Summer 2023	<u>Monitoring Method</u> Having waste monitors for KS1 and KS2 playgrounds to make sure the food waste is going into the compost bin. Quick class questionnaires to see if children are putting their food waste in the right place
<u>Aim</u> To reduce waste in the school		<u>Informing & Involving Plans</u> <u>Who will be involved?</u> Eco-Council, Miss Dawes (Eco- Coordinator), All children The council will inform their community through a whole-school assembly, posters and giving messages back to their individual classes to promote the compost bin and gardening club	<u>Final Evaluation</u>
<u>Eco-Schools Topic</u> Water	<u>Action</u> - Ask the Headteacher for the latest water bill. - Make posters to encourage children to turn the taps off when they are not being used. - Create a poster for adults at home to encourage prevention of water wastage. - Have a water Butt in the school and use the collected rainwater on the plants.	<u>Duration</u> Autumn-Spring 2023	<u>Monitoring Method</u> Through checking monthly water usage and seeing if we have managed to decrease the usage. Having children regularly check the toilets to make sure the taps are off when not being used. Create a short parent questionnaire to see if they find the poster helpful and if they have taken and ideas and used them
