Be creative with how you evidence your tasks!**

Can you plot your journey to school on a map? <i>Draw a map of your journey to school. Which roads do you travel on?</i> 4 house points	Do you know any stories that are set in a different country? <i>Tell us about a story you know well that is set in a different country.</i> 3 house points	Where have you been on holiday? <i>Can you find where you have been on holiday on a map or globe?</i> 2 house points
How do you travel to school? <i>Think about all the different ways you could travel to school.</i> 2 house points	Our topic this half term is...  'Around the World'	What is your favourite holiday destination? <i>Bring in a photograph of yourself on holiday to share with the class.</i> 2 house points
How might you travel to go on holiday? <i>Draw or cut and stick pictures of the different types of transport you could use to go on holiday.</i> 3 house points	Can you listen to some traditional music from another country, such as Spain? <i>You could sit and listen or you could come up with some dance moves to go with the music!</i> 3 house points	Can you try some food from a different country? <i>You could draw a picture or take a photo, and tell us what you thought about it – did you like it? What did you like/not like about it?</i> 3 house points
