

Looking Back Vol. 1: Exploring Singing Games

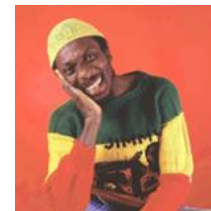
In this unit, we are going to be looking back on and listening to some of the music covered previously in Years 1-3.

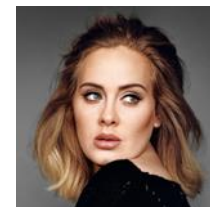

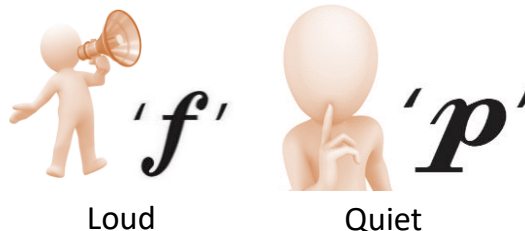

Crotchet =
1 beat



Crotchet rest =
1 beat of
silence



Minim = 2
beats



Semibreve
= 4 beats



1 quaver = $\frac{1}{2}$ beat
2 quavers = 1 full beat



Quaver rest = $\frac{1}{2}$
beat of silence

Pitch

Pitch is how high or low a sound is.



Smaller instruments tend
to have a higher pitch.



Flute

Larger instruments tend to
have a lower pitch.



Bassoon
