

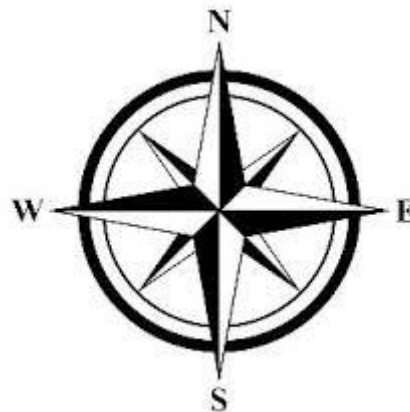
Curriculum overview
