Key vocabulary

Diversity	Two or more differences between people in a group.
Equity	Treating other's fairly by giving them what they need to be successful, even if those things are different.
Equality	Treating everyone in the same way regardless of their differences.
Stereotype	A fixed idea that many people have about a thing or a group that may be untrue or partly untrue.
Respect	Acting in a way that shows you care about their feelings and well-being.
Discrimination	Treating a person or group of people unfairly and differently to other people.
Tolerance	Accepting others who are difference from ourselves and treating them with kindness and fairly.

People should always demonstrate respect when voicing their opinions on important issues.

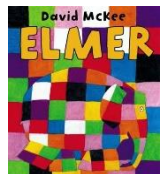
Discrimination can be shown through behaviours and actions.

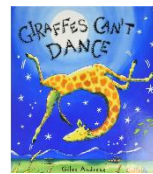
