

PE development through use of SSP funding 2018/19

Teaching of PE curriculum

- Resurface of KS1 playground has taken place due to staff concerns about its condition during PE sessions. Markings to be added after staff consultation.
- INSET – staff took part in a PE INSET last academic year and are implementing new planning and resources to improve provision.
- Staff meeting to discuss training needs/resources etc.
- Resurfacing of KS2 playground to be considered
- Supporting staff CPD – KS1 FUNDamentals coaches working with teachers in Rec, Y1 and Y2
- Support from SSP with action planning and spending of budget to improve curriculum
- SSP and DCCT 'bolt ons' to support curriculum delivery including Premier Reading Stars (Y5/6), Move and Learn programme, Communication and Listening Skills programme, mini-leaders training

Improving participation and School Sport

- Maintain lunch time provision and trained Y6 mini-leaders to support with games on playground
- Affiliation with Derby City SSP and DCCT who provide CPD opportunities, briefings for latest developments locally and nationally in PE, competitions and festivals, school improvement through PE etc.
- High level of participation in school sports: football league and tournament (local and county), netball fixtures, Premier Sports competitions, cross country competitions (local cluster and county wide), cricket, KS1 fundamentals festivals (Rec, Y1 and 2), celebration of dance, sports hall athletics, Brownlee Triathlon, along with other potential SSP festivals
- Regular meetings held with local cluster group to arrange sporting events. 'Tri-School Cup' tournament set up for Years 3/4 and Years 5/6. Fixtures still to be confirmed this year – meeting set up for next week.
- Relationship developed with Premier Sports (breakfast/after school club provider) to take part in out of school competitions.
- Maintenance of 'KS2 Trim Trail'.
- Building relationships with private schools (Trent, Ockbrook) – hold competitions including cross county, netball and cricket so far
- Bikeability scheduled for Y5 and Y6 this year.

Outdoor and adventurous activity

- Funding applied for and granted to train TB as a Forest Schools Level 3 Leader. Training taken place. Practical assessment passed. Written portfolio nearly completed!!! Trail sessions with target group (x10 KS2 children) underway and going well with support from CG as volunteer.
