Each week please complete the following tasks with your child.		
<u>Weekly task</u> To read on 4 occasions per week. (2 paper books, reading list in diary and a selection of online books are allocated each week) Those children with a Lexia allocation to do this in place of the online books.	To read and practise the words on the spelling list in readiness for the Friday test	To form all the numbers up to 20 accurately. To practise the addition and subtraction bonds to 10.

When you have completed a task, take it into school to share with your class teacher. Be creative with how you evidence your tasks!		
Draw your favourite toy at home. Write two sentences to describe it. 5 house points	Talk to grandparents or trusted older adults and ask them about their childhood toys. Discuss the similarities and differences. Film this to share with the class. 5 house points	Go on a walk around your local area. Note down the signs of autumn and the onset of winter. (leaves turning, animals gathering food for winter) 5 house points
Draw a living thing that hibernates during the winter. For 5 house points, write a sentence about how it hibernates. 2-5 house points	Our topic this half term is... <i>Science: Autumn and Winter</i> <i>History: Toys</i>	Sort your toys into categories of wheeled toys, dolls/figures, electronic, construction. Can you think of any other categories? 5 house points
With adult supervision, record the temperature each day for a week. Record this on a chart. 5 house points	Listen to your favourite piece of music, Can you clap the pulse of the music? Show us in class. 1 house point	Write a letter to someone in the class to describe all the things you like about them. 5 house points
