Where is it? Find and label North, East, South and West in your garden. 2 house points	What are the pirates like? Write a list of adjectives to describe a pirate ship and use them to write facts about pirates. 2 house points	Can you find your way? Draw a sketch map of your journey to school, including key landmarks you can see. 3 house points
How do they taste? Investigate different fruits and vegetables by doing a taste test. What is the same and different about them? Record your results in a table. 4 house points	Our topic this half term is...  'Magical Mapping'	How does your garden grow? Plant a variety of seeds and compare what they look like and how they grow. Can you record your results in an interesting way? 5 house points
What do they need? Create a leaflet to explain what plants need to grow and stay healthy. 4 house points	Can you sing a pirate song? Learn and sing a pirate song to an adult at home. 2 house points	Can you count in 10s Use objects to count in 10. You could use objects in your house or from outside in nature. 2 house points
