Support your child to re-read their book more than once to help develop their comprehension skills and fluency.</i>	Practise your weekly spelling words. <i>Each week there will be 8 focus words linked to our phonics sound/spelling rule and 2 common exception words. Use the Twinkl Phonics app to help you!</i>	Practise your 2s, 5s and 10 times table. <i>You can do this by writing them down, counting using objects or making rhymes.</i>
