Each week please complete the following tasks with your child.		
To read at least 4X per week to an adult, checking fluency, accuracy and comprehension. Adults should sign reading diaries. Books will be changed on a Monday and Thursday.	To read, write and say the words on the spelling list, which will be sent home every Monday, in readiness for the Monday spelling test. You can also practise weekly spellings via the Twinkl platform.	To practise times table recall and division facts using the Times Table Rockstars and www.timestables.co.uk platform. To check fluency, speed and accuracy of tables recall with an adult.

When you have completed a task, take it into school to share with your class teacher. Be creative with how you evidence your tasks!
