## Each week please complete the following tasks with your child.

To **read** at least 4X per week to an adult, checking fluency, accuracy, and comprehension. Adults should sign reading diaries. Children can change their own book.

To read, write and say the words on the **spelling** list, which will be sent home every Monday, in readiness for the Monday spelling test. You can also practise weekly spellings via the Spelling Shed platform.

To practise **times table,** recall and division facts using the Times Table Rockstars platform. To check fluency, speed and accuracy of tables recall with an adult. (This will continue even after the multiplication check)

When you have completed a task, take it into school to share with your class teacher.  Be creative with how you evidence your tasks!
