

Once finished, take a picture of your suncatcher outside to see if it works.</p> <p>House Points- 4</p>	<p>Task: Weather Report Recreate a weather report of a bad storm or heavy rain forecast. This can be recorded at home and sent in or performed in class.</p> <p>House Point- 4</p>
<p>Task: Light Round-up! Look around your home. Can you create a list of at least 10 different items that create light.
