<p>Draw your favourite toy at home. Write two sentences to describe it. 5 house points</p>	<p>Talk to grandparents or trusted older adults and ask them about their childhood toys. Discuss the similarities and differences. Film this to share with the class. 5 house points</p>	<p>Go on a walk around your local area. Note down the signs of autumn and the onset of winter. (leaves turning, animals gathering food for winter)  5 house points</p>
<p>Draw a living thing that hibernates during the winter. For 5 house points, write a sentence about how it hibernates. 2-5 house points</p>	<p><b>Our topic this half term is...</b> <i>Science: Autumn and Winter</i> <i>History: Toys</i></p>	<p>Sort your toys into categories of wheeled toys, dolls/figures, electronic, construction. Can you think of any other categories?  5 house points</p>
