Each week please complete the following tasks with your child.		
To read at least 4X per week to an adult, checking fluency, accuracy, and comprehension. Adults should sign reading diaries. Books will be changed daily when needed.	To read, write and say the words on the spelling list, which will be sent home every Monday, in readiness for the Monday spelling test. You can also practise weekly spellings via the Twinkl platform.	To practise multiplication facts up to 12x12, using Times Table Rockstars. To check fluency, speed and accuracy of tables recall with an adult.
