**Each week please complete the following tasks with your child.**

To **read** at least 4X per week to an adult, checking fluency, accuracy, and comprehension. Adults should sign reading diaries. Books will be changed daily when needed.

To read, write and say the words on the **spelling** list, which will be sent home every Monday, in readiness for the Monday spelling test. You can also practise weekly spellings via the Spelling Shed platform.

To practise **times table, rapid recall** of multiplication facts using the Times Table Rockstars platform. To check fluency, speed and accuracy of tables recall with an adult regularly.

**When you have completed a task, take it into school to share with your class teacher.  
Be creative with how you evidence your tasks!**

Look at some of his wallpaper designs and use these to inspire you to create your very own nature themed wallpaper.</p> <p><b>House points=3 points</b></p>	<p><b>Geography-</b>find out facts about the Arctic and write a non-chronological report. Clues-What is the Arctic Circle? Which countries are there? What kinds of animals might you see? What would the weather be like? <p><b>House points = 4 points</b></p> <p>Conduct an experiment at home to find out how to melt chocolate. What temperature does it melt at? You could always turn it into something delicious, like chocolate crispy cakes, and see how the liquid chocolate solidifies again. Present your work as a poster and illustrate. (maybe with Penguins!) Your work must be presented neatly to gain the maximum number of house points available.</p> <p><b>House Points = 3 points</b></p>
<p><b>French-</b> Find the names for the days of the week and months of the year. Make a poster for our class display.</p> <p><b>House points = 2 points</b></p>	<p><b>English-</b> Write a review about a book that you have read recently. What was your book about? Why did you enjoy it so much? Who would enjoy reading this book?
