Each week please complete the following tasks with your child.

Read with your child and support them to sound out and blend words – 10 minutes, 4-5 times a week.

Log onto Num-bots using the details inside their reading diary, and practice number bonds and counting – 3 minutes, 3-4 times a week.

Share stories with your child and ask them questions to get them to predict what might happen next in the story.

When you have completed a task, take it into school to share with your class teacher.

Be creative with how you evidence your tasks!

What is your favourite animal?

Make a factfile about your favourite animal!
What do they look like? Where do they live? What do they eat? Find one interesting fact about them!
